## VISUAL ARTS INTRODUCED

20 selected students at Swastha's Suntiokoppa Centre have been introduced to learning Visual Art since June 2017, with regular classes conducted on a twice-a-week schedule. Each session is an 90 minutes module combining interactive and practical classes. A very basic principle taught to them is to 'observe' – learn how to 'see', measure the object within the space and transfer the information into a drawing – a way to remember ideas and put images into visual database. The 3-Dimensional world what we see around is captured into a 2- Dimensional surface using elements such as lines – shape – color – value – texture – space and form. The art educator encourages creative self-expression as they learn technical skills.

They have also been provided a platform to interact and create art works with regular children during a day-long Inclusive Art Interaction programme – 'Petals' organized at our centre.
